Field Research Intern – Amphibian Ecology in Floodplain Systems

Compensation:

Internship Description:

- This intern will work with FLBS personnel to conduct visual encounter surveys along floodplain wetlands, ponds, and stream margins during peak activity times with a focus on Boreal Toads.
- The intern will characterize breeding sites: water depth, temperature, pH, conductivity, dissolved oxygen, as well as local habitat characteristics (substrate, vegetation)
- The intern will use historical imagery to track floodplain pools through time

- Must be a continuing undergraduate student

- Applicant should have coursework or experience with wildlife/ecology background emphasis on knowledge of amphibians and amphibian survey techniques
